Autism is a lifelong neurological condition that affects how individuals communicate, interact, and learn. While autism presents challenges, individuals on the Autism Spectrum also possess a wide range of abilities, strengths, and potential that can flourish when the right supports are in place.

In 2025, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reported that approximately **1 in 31 children** in the **United States** has been diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)—a significant increase from previous years. This rise reflects greater awareness and improved access to evaluations, underscoring the growing need for specialized educational programs and community support.

Since 1973, the **Burger School for Students with Autism**, a center-based program operated by Garden City Public Schools, has been dedicated to educating students with autism in a safe, structured, and supportive environment. Burger School currently serves approximately **160 students from 18 Wayne County school districts** across two locations:

- **Burger Baylor**, serving students **ages 6–18**
- **The Transition Center**, serving young adults **ages 18–26**, with a focus on independence, life skills, and post-school readiness

The **Burger Autistic School Association, Inc. (BASA)** is a nonprofit organization made up entirely of dedicated teachers and family members of Burger students. BASA's mission is to enhance the educational experience of Burger students by providing funding for classroom materials, adaptive equipment, technology, enrichment programs, and family support initiatives. As a volunteer-run organization, BASA ensures that donations are used efficiently and have a direct impact on students' daily learning and well-being.

The annual Autos for Autism Car Show is BASA's **largest and most vital fundraiser**, making many of these programs and resources possible. This year's event marks a meaningful milestone—the **25th Annual Autos for Autism Car Show, taking place on Monday, June 15, 2026, from 4:00 to 9:00 p.m.**
